History Create a fact page/powerpoint or booklet with facts about the Stone Age. These facts could include things about what they wore, what they ate and what life was like living in this period.	History In the Neolithic period people began to settle more in villages and started to domesticate animals. Use an image like below to inspire and create your own model village.	History Use images of cave paintings to create your own piece of artwork. Draw animals from the period and use earthy colours like we see in the pictures.
Science Research the animal diets of one or more animals. Plan a menu for them.	Science We will be learning about balanced diets. Why not bake/create/make a healthy snack.	Science Create a skeleton image. You could use black paper and draw a skeleton in white chalk or you could find a creative way. Label the bones.
R.E This term we are learning about God's Creation. Created a piece of artwork or model to represent what God's creation means to you.	R.E There are so many wonderful parts of God's creation. Write your own poem with this theme.	R.E Create a poster about how we can care for the planet and look after God's creation. It might be that you create a poster around recycling or remembering to turn the lights off or not wasting water.
