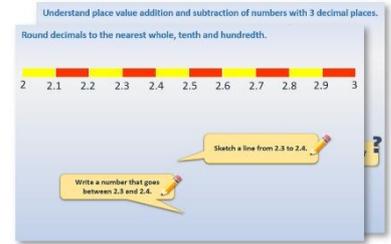


# Week 11, Day 3

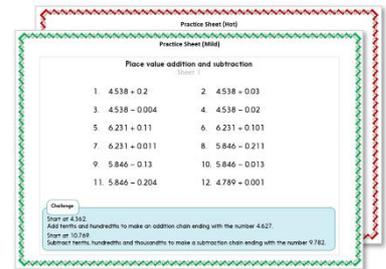
## Symmetry

Each day covers one maths topic. It should take you about 1 hour or just a little more.

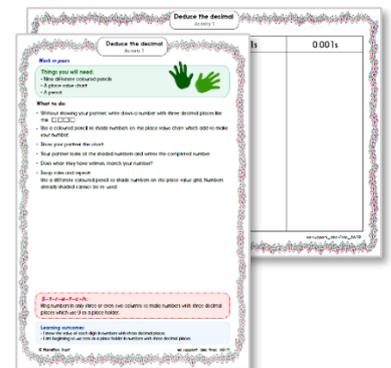
1. Start by reading through the **Learning Reminders**. They come from our *PowerPoint* slides.



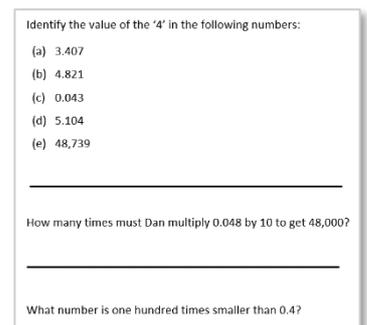
2. Tackle the questions on the **Practice Sheet**. There might be a choice of either **Mild** (easier) or **Hot** (harder)! Check the answers.

## A Bit Stuck? Folding houses

### Things you will need:

- Pictures of houses (see resources)



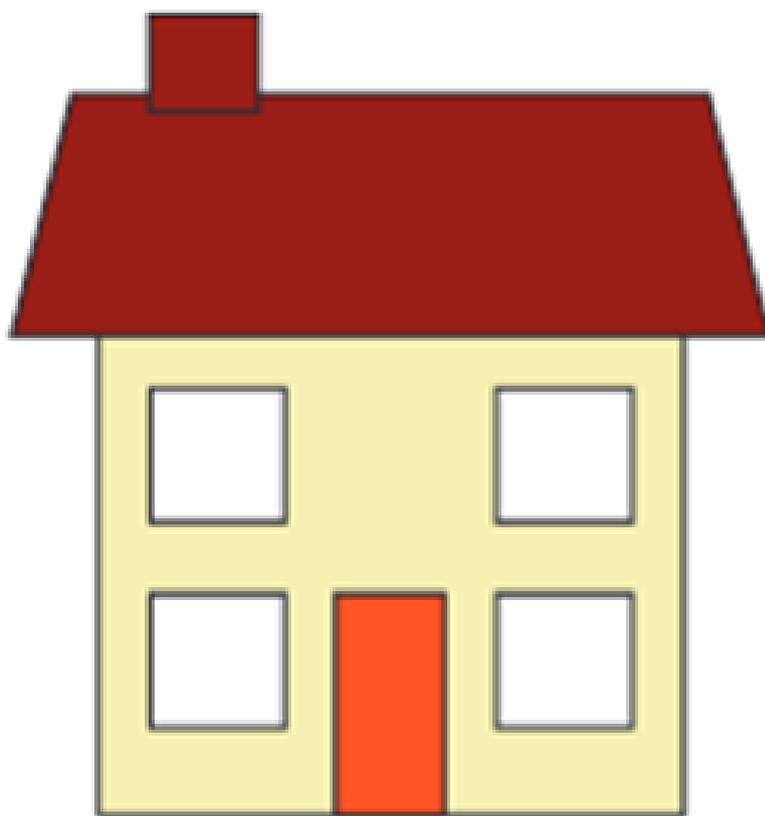
### What to do:

- Look at the first house on the sheet (see resources)



- Can you fold the paper so that the picture is exactly the same on either side of the fold line – is it symmetrical?  
If you hold it up to the light, you should be able to see lines sitting on top of one another, or you can check by placing a small mirror along the fold.
- Open it out again. Is it symmetrical if you fold it any other way?
- Now look at the next house. Is it symmetrical?
- What could you do to it to make it symmetrical?
- Repeat for the next house.
- Now draw your own symmetrical house, block of flats or bungalow.

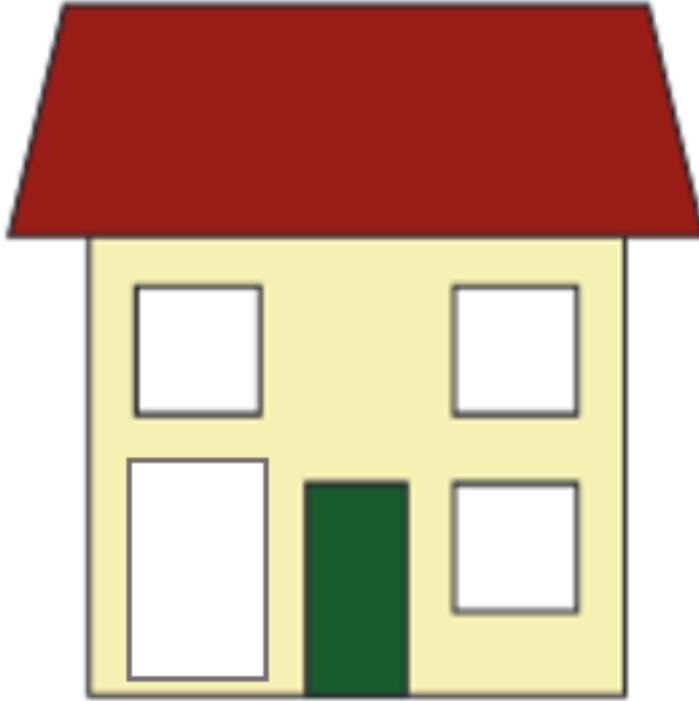

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### Check your understanding: Answers

Draw lines of symmetry on these shapes:



Watch out for children who assume that a line of symmetry must be vertical. Check with a mirror.

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Draw a 2-D shape with at least 1 curved side and 2 lines of symmetry.

Shape may be ovoid, or resemble a 'rounded' rectangle, e.g.



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How many lines of symmetry in a regular pentagon? 5.

These go from each of the 5 vertices to the mid-point of the opposite side.
