

Understanding English, communication and languages:

Scientific and technological understanding:

Computing

We will develop our understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs. Start by comparing digital and non-digital devices, before introducing computer networks that include network infrastructure devices like routers and switches.

Mathematical understanding:

This year we will be following a scheme of work called Power Maths. Our first units of work focus on developing fluency and understanding within numbers to 1000.

We will begin by focusing on place value before moving onto developing understanding in addition and subtraction.

French

Our first half term of French will see us learning greetings and introductions, some basic words and phrases and beginning to explore some facts about France.

History

European History - Prehistoric Britain

An introduction to Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

This unit will include a trip to Woodbury Castle Fort.
