Understanding English, communication and languages:

We will learn to write a twist on a traditional tale. We will learn how to structure a traditional tale and what features to use at various plot points.

Sentence structure work—We will learn how to write sentences using subordinate conjunctions and revise the Year 2 grammar skills.

Scientific and technological understanding

- We will learn what bend, squash, twist and stretch means.
- We will learn what happens to certain materials when you bend, squash, twist and stretch them and we will compare the properties of materials to these actions.
